4. Panel Updates:

- a. Directorate of Emergency Services MAJ Eddie Porter discussed military scams, off-limits establishments and weapon registration. Most common scams are employment, home improvement and on-line scams. AR 190-11 and MCoE Policy Memorandum 190-11 cover weapon registration. You have 10 days to register a weapon including recreational use (hunting and Recreational Shooting Complex). Updated off-limits establishments policy is undergoing a legal review. COL Mahle stated five ACPs are undergoing memorialization, the first one taking place 16 November at ACP 8. - b. MACH LTC Melinda Wallace discussed the flu drive at MACH for children 6 35 months and adults 65 and older. Patrons are asked to make an appointment. Open flu drives available to all other Family members in Occupational Health. Many off-post pharmacies offer flu shots and accept TRICARE. TRICARE season opens 13 November and closes 12 December to change enrollment type. MACH hours of operation vary for training and federal holidays.
