

#### **School & Sports Physicals**

#### **School & Sports Physicals**

- Encouraged to call and schedule yearly well visits (WCC). Our protocol is to triage the need and provide yearly check up/WCC one calendar year from the last one.
  - Parents are encouraged to schedule their child's annual visit which includes full exam, vaccines, vision/hearing, and any paperwork that the child will need for school or sports.
  - If a child already has a visit on file within the last 11 months, all paperwork for school and sports can be filled when the form is sent to the child's primary care provider.
- We understand the summer PCS cycle or changing schools / requirements with resulting need for school forms & vaccines. That is why we scheduled extended hours and a Saturday.
- Our goal is for patients to have their yearly visits and to provide them with what they will need for school and sports.





#### **Appointment Etiquette**

#### On-Time:

- Encouraged to arrive 10 minutes early for appointment. Approximately 15% of patients are late for their appointments. The impact of this is the provider being late for his/her following appointments.
- In the near-future, we will reschedule if over 10 minutes late. Ideally same-day but cannot guarantee.
- <u>No-Show</u>: Once it is known an appointment will be missed (the sooner the better), please cancel. Doing so opens the appointment slot for another patient.
- <u>Virtual</u>: If it is a virtual appointment, encouraged to connect via Wi-Fi versus using cell service which may have a weak cell signal.





#### **WORSHIP SERVICES**


Weekly worship services are the heartbeat of religious support across the installation!




