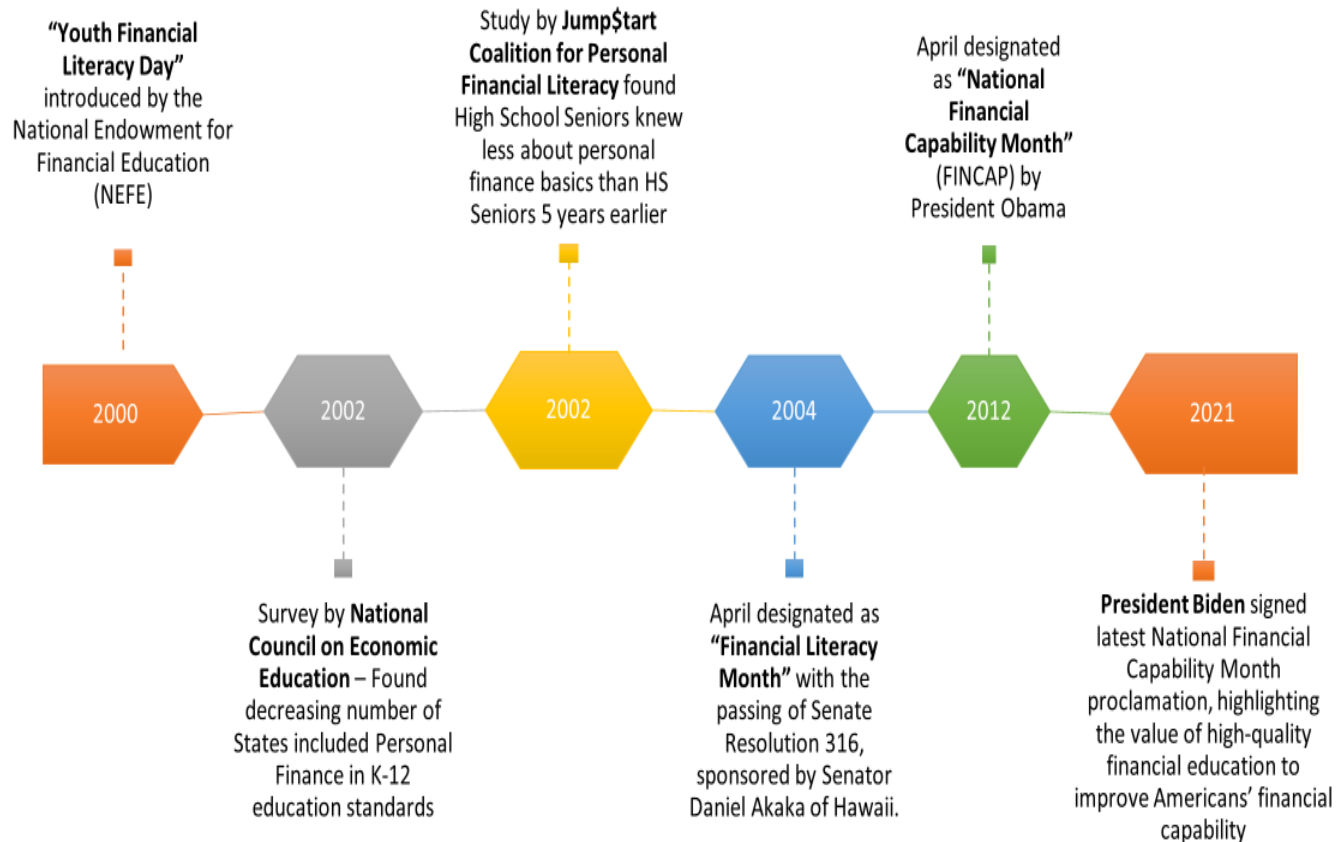

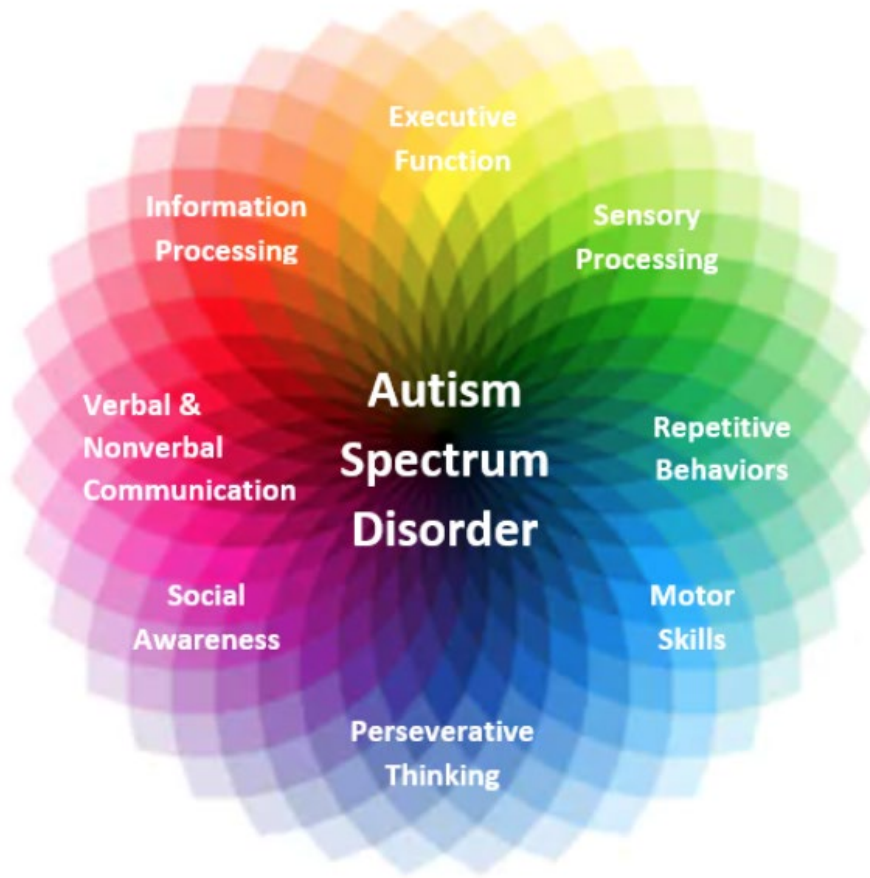

School & Sports Physicals

- Parents are encouraged to schedule their child's annual visit which includes full exam, vaccines, vision/hearing, and any paperwork that the child will need for school or sports.
- In the summer:
 - The pediatric clinic will have one week in June, July, and August with extended hours (1700-2000) to accommodate for extra appointments as well as one Saturday in August.
 - Currently, dates are unknown as this plan is being developed.
- If a child already has a visit on file within the last 11 months, all paperwork for school and sports can be filled when the form is sent to the child's primary care provider.
- Our goal is for patients to have their yearly visits and to provide them with what they will need for school and sports.



Patient and Family Partnership Council

- MACH seeks beneficiary volunteers including active-duty personnel, active-duty family members, retirees, retiree family members, and TRICARE Plus or TRICARE for Life beneficiaries.

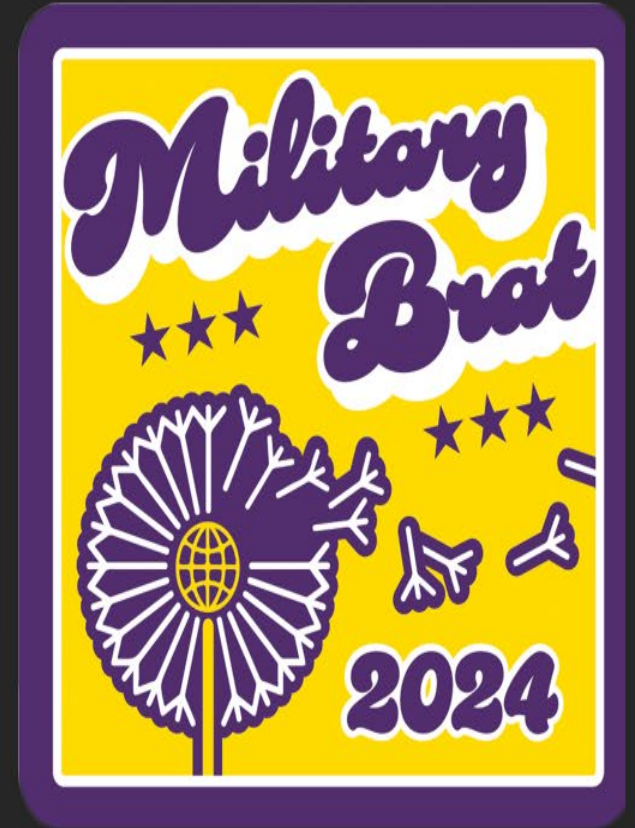

WORSHIP SERVICES

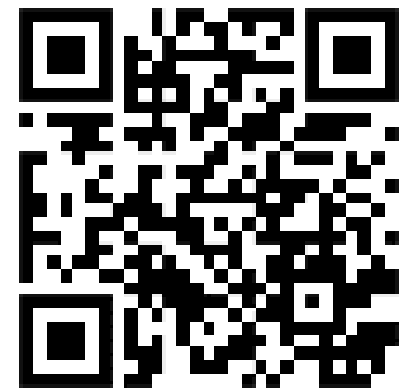
Weekly worship services are the heartbeat of religious support across the installation!
